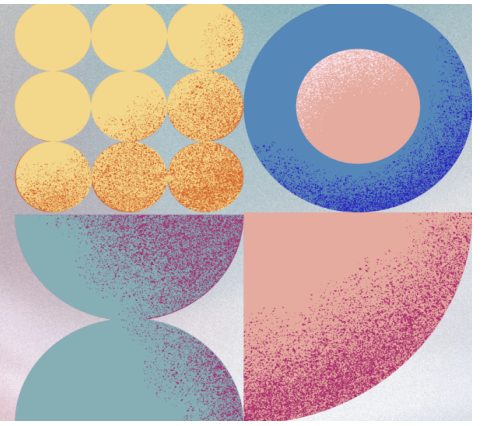


Art Through the Seasons

Building & Business Commitment

Project targets seasonally closed and vacant storefronts.



Local Art Printed on Window Cling

Art passes through selection committee. Assigned to storefronts for maximum appeal.



Installation & Removal

Window clings are installed and removed free of charge. No adhesive and no damage.



Repeat Annually
